Letter from Julie

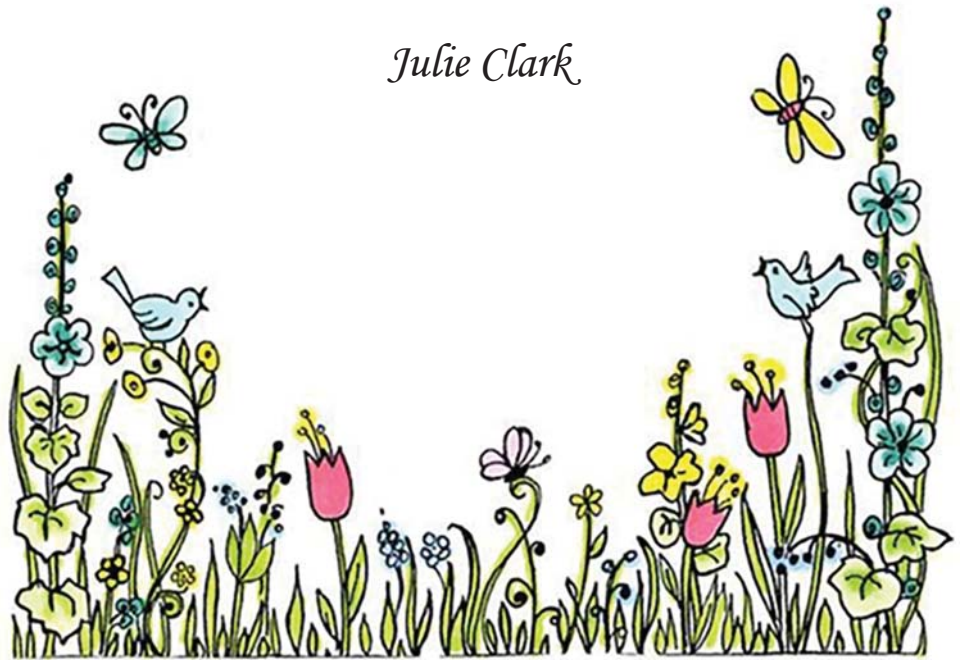
